- ▼ **GOAL 1** End poverty in all its forms everywhere
 - ▼ **TARGET 1.1** By 2030, eradicate extreme poverty for all people everywhere, currently measured on less than \$1.25 a day
 - ▶ **INDICATOR 1.1.1** Proportion of the population living below the international poverty line, by employment status and geographic location (urban/rural)
 - ▼ **TARGET 1.2** By 2030, reduce at least by half the proportion of men, women and children of poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions
 - ▶ **INDICATOR 1.2.1** Proportion of population living below the national poverty line, by sex
