




Figure 2. The relationship of the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) to the framework of ecological economics and the overarching goal of a sustainable, equitable and prosperous system (Costanza et al. 2016. Modelling and measuring sustainable wellbeing in connection with the UN Sustainable Development Goals. *Ecological Economics*.

SGDs vs Millennium Development Goals (2000-2014)

1. The Sustainable Development Goals Will Be More

Comprehensive in Scope

Not only social issues

2. The Sustainable Development Goals Will Seek a More Integrative Approach to Development

3. The Sustainable Development Goals Will Operate on a Universal Scale

The MDGs focused primarily on how the developed world could finance improvements in developing nations.

The SDGs, however, speak to poverty in all nations (developed and developing). **no one is left behind.**

4. Data Revolution:

The MDGs said nothing about monitoring, evaluation and accountability the SDGs target by 2020 to "increase significantly the availability of highquality, timely and reliable data disaggregated by income, gender, age, race, ethnicity, migratory status, disability, geographic location and other characteristics relevant in national contexts."
