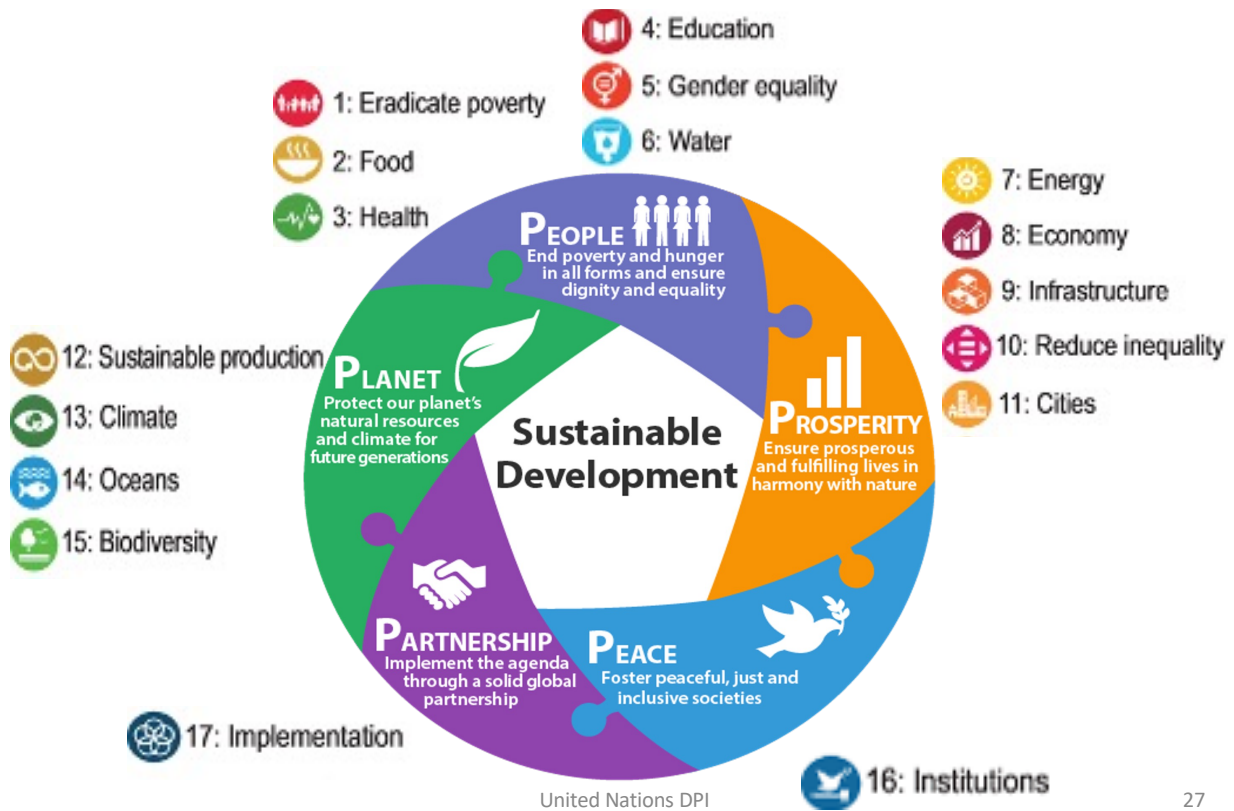

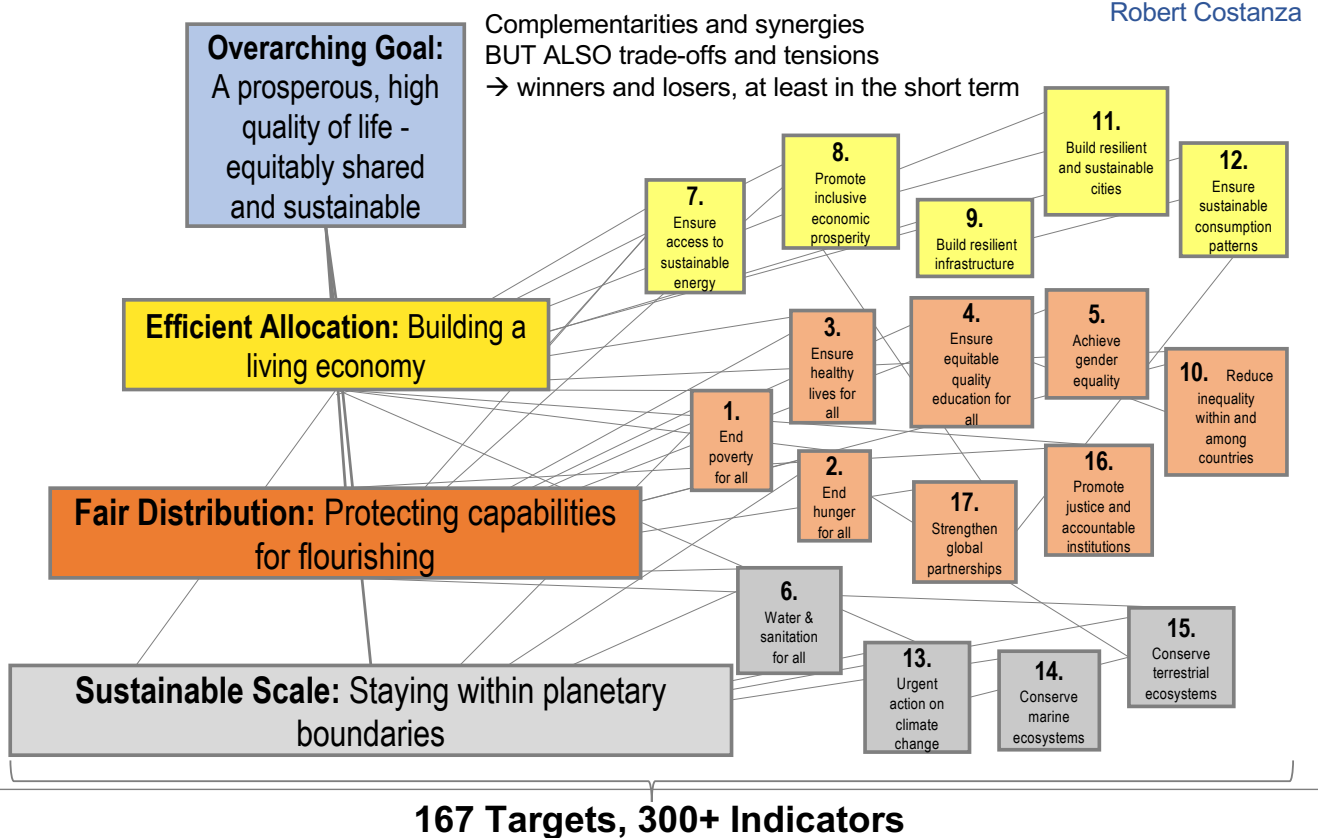

## 2. The Sustainable Development Goals Will Seek a More Integrative Approach to Development

## 3. The Sustainable Development Goals Will Operate on a Universal Scale

The MDGs focused primarily on how the developed world could finance improvements in developing nations.

The SDGs, however, speak to poverty in all nations (developed and developing). **no one is left behind.**

## 4. Data Revolution:

The MDGs said nothing about monitoring, evaluation and accountability the SDGs target by 2020 to “increase significantly the availability of high-quality, timely and reliable data disaggregated by income, gender, age, race, ethnicity, migratory status, disability, geographic location and other characteristics relevant in national contexts.”

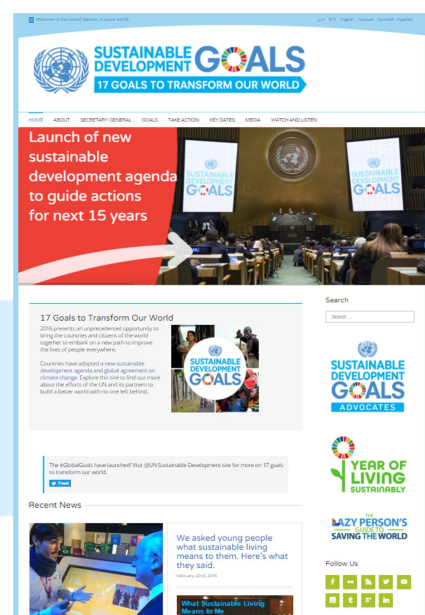

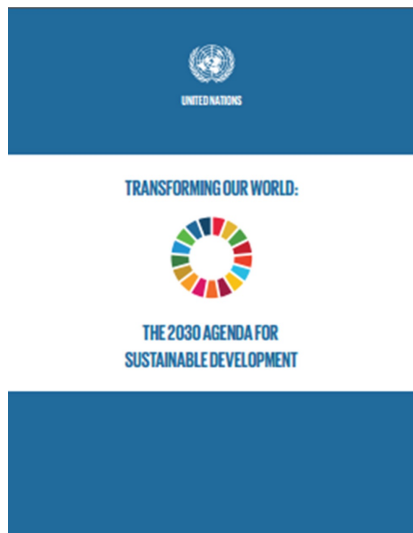
